

USB DRIVER INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Windows 2000/xp/2003 Server/Vista (x86, x64)

1. Run the file “CP210x_VCP_Win2K_XP_S2K3.exe” found on the disk or download it from:

choosing the VCP Driver kit for your operating system.

CP210x USB to UART Bridge VCP Drivers

The CP210x USB to UART Bridge Virtual COM Port (VCP) drivers are required for device operation as a Virtual COM Port to facilitate host communication with [CP210x](#) products. These devices can also interface to a host using the [USBXpress](#) direct access driver.




This will launch the driver un-packer utility. You may see the following warning which you may ignore, just click on the run button.




2. The introduction page will appear:



3. Click on next and the following screen will appear:




4. Accept the terms of the license agreement and click on next:




5. Click next or browse to install to a different directory.

6. Then you will see:




7. Click on install. When the following screen appears, click on the box beside "Launch the CP210x VCP Driver installer" and then click on finish.
